Colony Alive Report by Ruby R and Soham R on behalf of the Year 2/3/4 students.

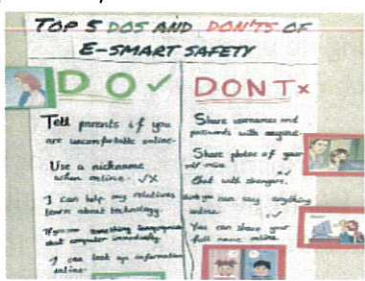
