WET WEATHER DISMISSAL: We have made a slight change to the arrangements that were emailed to you through the week, mainly concerning **Grade 3/4 JD** who will now be dismissed from the staffroom to ease the foyer congestion. Parents can congregate under the staffroom veranda, the rest is the same ie.

Parents of children in **Gr P/1 B and Gr P/1 S** can wait for their children under the verandas outside the P/1 classrooms or in the shared area between the two rooms.

Parents of children in **Gr 1/2 B, Gr 1/2 CE and Grade 3/4 F** can wait in the corridors of the main building. Parents of children in Grades **4/5 K, 5/6 F and 5/6 P** can wait in the multi-purpose room or under the verandas outside the canteen, staffroom and multi-purpose room.

If you have more than one child at the school I suggest you wait in the area for the Grade your youngest child is in and instruct your older children to meet you there.

Please ensure you maintain a 1.5m distance from each other if possible.

To avoid having to sign you all in, we ask that you stay no longer than 10 mins at the school. This means arriving no earlier than 2^{-1} pm and leaving no later than 3.20 pm.
