

### RELIGION:

The students will be focusing on the Sacraments of Initiation and the significance of these celebrations in a Catholic person's life. They will also investigate the Sacrament of Confirmation and the students will be learning about the Fruits and Gifts of the Holy Spirit and how people can use these to serve one another.

### ART:

Students will create artwork within the areas of painting, drawing and modelling. They will use and select a variety of modelling tools and skilled techniques to create a 3D sculpture of nutritional foods. They will use their knowledge and experiences of the elements of art to add detail and a realistic appearance to their piece.

### SEL:

This term in SEL the students will continue to participate in Class Meetings and will continue to explore the SEL competencies. They will be learning about self-management skills and will be given the opportunity to participate in BluEarth activities that teach the students about social interactions and decision making.

### LITERACY:

The senior students will be involved in reading and writing short stories. They will focus on the ways the story introduction seeks to engage the reader. Language features, such as the use of adverbs and adverbials, dialogue and words that signal the passing of time will be studied. Students will write short narratives and create infographs. The skills of summarising and paraphrasing will be emphasised. Speaking and listening will be central to our literacy lessons, and students will be many opportunities to work collaboratively on literacy tasks. Home reading will continue to support our school reading program.



### INQUIRY:


The students will be focusing on the question: What are our responsibilities in regard to food? They will be learning about food production and food safety. The students will investigate the process that food production undergoes and the safety, health and hygiene practises that are essential in food handling. They will be putting their knowledge into practise by planning and preparing a meal that utilizes the food handling skills they have learnt about.



## TERM 2 GRADE 5/6 SENIOR LEARNING OVERVIEW

### ITALIAN:

This term in Italian, we will be learning how to order at an Italian restaurant. We will be learning the vocabulary and phrases to then write our own role plays. Students will revise numbers and learn how to follow number patterns to 1000.



### PERFORMING ARTS:

This Term in Performing Arts students will explore different musical genres and deepen their knowledge by developing their own compositions. They will use improvisation and movement to create sequences to accompany their music.

### MATHS:

The students will be constructing and interpreting different styles of graphs. They will learn how to read information in a range of different forms. In preparation for NAPLAN, later this term, the students will work on problem solving strategies and will familiarize themselves with the new online NAPLAN platform. We will also explore elapsed time problems and we will continue to work on multiplication and division.

### P.E.:

For the first half of Term 2 students will be learning and practising a variety of track and field skills supported by visiting coaches from Athletics Australia. Students will continue to work on their fitness and stamina through participating in middle distance running activities and high energy games. Western Bulldogs Football Club representatives will be coaching AFL clinics for the second half of term in preparation for winter Interschool Sports.
