Spotlight on Student Wellbeing

Aside from being our wonderful Deputy Principal Marie Gamwell also is our Leader in our efforts to promote and nurture the wellbeing and social and emotional learning (SEL) of the children at St Theresa's. Marie has initiated and implemented many proactive programs in this area such as Mindfulness, CASEA, BluEarth etc. One of the things that we also do in relation to SEL is that each year we survey all of the children about their views and attitudes to their own social and emotional wellbeing. The surveys are developed by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) and are done on-line. ACER collates the student responses and then provides the school with the results. This provides us with valuable information about student attitudes and feeling about a whole range of things that affect them on a social and emotional level and allows us to proactively help them in their development in these aspects of their life. If you would like more information we will be conducting a community conversation about Student Wellbeing and Social & Emotional Learning later in the year.
