ThinkUKnow Australia is a cyber safety education program that educates parents, carers and teachers of

how people are using technology, the challenges they may face online, and how to help them overcome these in a safe and ethical way.

The presentation covers issues relating to children's privacy and security online, their relationships with other users and their online reputation. It provides insight into the devices children are using, as well as the popular websites, apps and social networking sites they're accessing.
