

Mathematics

In Maths we will be applying place value knowledge to partition and regroup numbers and to solve problems. We will look at the ways that number patterns can be used to help solve addition, subtraction and multiplication problems including those involving money. We will conduct chance experiments and assess the outcomes of them. Later in the term, we will measure length using scaled instruments and compare and classify angles.

Art

In Art the children will be working within the different areas of art painting, collage, drawing) students will experience and explore using mixed media in their artistic creations. They will learn how and why artists choose a combination of different medium in one piece of work. Through these activities, their understandings of the elements of art will deepen. Dutch artist, M.C Escher will be introduced to the students and they will discuss, observe and create artwork inspired by his style.



Italian

This term in Italian we will be revising our greetings and engage in simple conversations with each other in Italian, using the vocabulary to introduce ourselves. Students will be introduced to intentional gesturing in Italian as a way of remembering new words and phrases. We will revise our numbers to 100. Our Easter unit will be focusing on Italian Easter traditions.

Inquiry

Term One Inquiry has a Student Wellbeing focus. The students will learn about ways we can be aware of our own emotions and how we respond. We will be looking at ways students can further their wellbeing and how this can support positive relationships with others. The students will have the opportunity to experience wellbeing activities that involve physical, emotional and spiritual well being. They will develop their own wellbeing experiences to run with other students.
